Other Helpful Details:

Prices for airfare, transfers, and pre-cruise hotel accommodations will be available for anyone who needs to fly into Houston/Galveston. Houston is the closest airport, and is about 45 minutes from the cruise port. Details about these other travel arrangements will be open for discussion (around July 2021). Today, you can lock in your cruise price and room location by joining the trip. Deposit is \$200 per person, and is refundable until August 1.

Sightseeing excursions, including group shipboard events with Finley River Boys will be communicated later in the fall of 2021. Off-ship sightseeing excursions will have additional costs, with details and reservations for those to be made available with plenty notice before our cruise departs.

Covid19 Travel Situation is ever changing. This virus has been a major impact to travel. As of February 1, 2021, the cruise industry has been paused in their operations. Carnival, specifically, is not sailing, and their current resumption date is planned for May 1st. Further details on the resumption of their cruises, and any regulations or restrictions that could be in place during the next phase of cruising, including the near future, has not been communicated yet. While we know things may be different, it doesn't make any sense to assume anything at this point. This can cast some doubt on the cruise experience, but we also know that sometime soon, cruises will resume. With any luck things will be much better and the health concerns will be in our rearview mirror. Regardless of how you feel about things today, it's important that you remain comfortable with the everchanging rules and regulations that could be associated to travel. For some peace of mind, our group program prices are refundable until August 1, 2021. At that point we hope to have the clearance to move forward with less concerns, and the dream of traveling in the near future on your cruise.
